 - o A couple of notes for next year: decorating could have used more organization and help from a parent to lead the group. It would also be beneficial to start collecting decorations earlier and the Crownover family offered to have the trailer available earlier or to store decorations beforehand. Shoutout to Evan Welch for going above and beyond in helping with set up and take down before and after the parade.
- Behind the Scenes Parent Tour The tour of the Stony Point PAC highlighted a few of the things that are available to other schools, because they use the PAC as classroom space, that we don't have access to at RRHS. They have a workshop, costume closet, prop room and regular access to studio lights, sound and other tech available as part of their classroom. The big take away is that we are encouraging parents to join any groups that help advocate for theatre (and arts in general) as the district moves forward with the bond planning. If we hear of groups that are looking for parent input we will be sure to share those with our members. Kelly Gumbert and Jennifer Green have joined the Parent Advisory Committee to be sure that arts are represented in discussions concerning RRHS.

Fall Show

- There will be volleyball games in the gym on Thursday and Friday of the shows so the parking lot closest to that area will likely be quite full and the gates to our hallway will be closed. • Thespian State Updates

- 30 students will be attending, participating in 15 events. Some are duos, some individual and 7 in the tech relay.
- There will be an information night for Mr Irwin to go over expectations with the kids while they are at the competition. He will share any other info they need at that time. Date it TBD after the fall show, after school. He will send an email to parents with schedules and hotel information when he gets it. He also encourages parents to follow their kids' Google Classroom updates to get information as it comes out.

Musical Needs

- District has a magician that is helping to build some illusions into the play, we may look for additional resources to help with this as need arises.
- Irwin has a fight choreographer to help with a couple scenes, same person we used for Death of a Salesman.
- Regular rehearsals will start right after the fall show finishes. They have already had a couple dance rehearsals.
- We purchased the logo pack to use for posters and online posts but Irwin would like to create something more specific to our show. He will reach out with ideas to see if we can help him execute. Monica W. may be able to help with original art and Michelle C can help with design
- Custodial fees are \$35 per hour, with a 4 hour minimum, for use of the facilities on Saturdays. We will adjust the budget to be sure we cover these costs.
- HAYAS have asked for a student and parent liaison this year and Ryan and Tilly Crosby volunteered.

TREASURER REPORT......Paige Morgan

- Beginning balance on 9/1/25: \$14,112.93 / Ending balance on 9/30/25: \$14,096.56
- We were able to support 2 students with the cost of Thespian State fees, using \$650 of the \$900 budgeted.
- We helped out with the ordering of the Fall play shirts this year. \$1 profit was made per shirt and was used to purchase a short for Mr Irwin and Mr Hobby.
- 3 budget considerations/requests:
 - Adding Wave Accounting Pro to the budget to allow for better tracking of financials that are tied to our bank account specifically. This is will increase our operating budget by \$190. A motion was made to add this item to our annual budget by Kelly G and 2nd by Burke C. Unanimously approved
 - Boosters would like to continue to help the directors with the fall show shirt orders, this would add a budget line item for Fall Show Shirt Expenses in the amount of \$1,068 (will vary year to year.) A motion was made by Dipa K and 2nd by Heather B. Unanimously approved.
 - We would like to have 2 separate line items for decor for the Fall show and Spring Musical, instead of pulling funds for both shows from the same pool.
 Adding a budget line item for Fall Show Decor of \$300. A motion was made by Dipa K and 2nd by Jennifer G. Unanimously approved
